

Author Guidelines

The Scientific Committee of the 3rd International Conference on Resources and Technology, organized by GMIT, is inviting the submission of original research manuscripts to the Conference Proceedings, which will be published by Atlantis Press in the Series of Advances in Engineering Research.

Manuscripts should be submitted and evaluated according to the following timeline:

- **Abstract submission deadline:** March 15, 2025 (extended to **April 30, 2025**)
- **Notification of acceptance deadline:** March 30, 2025 (extended to **May 10, 2025**)
- **Submission of full paper for the Conference Proceedings in Atlantis Press in the Series of Advances in Engineering Research deadline:** May 1, 2025 (extended to **May 30, 2025**)

If you are submitting a full paper to the Proceedings of the 3rd International Conference on Resources and Technology (RESAT 2025), please follow the guidelines below.

The submission platform is Springer Nature Meteor.

General Guidelines

- The submission platform opened on March 20, 2025. The link to the platform is provided above.
- To begin, you have to register with the Springer Meteor platform, after which you can login to prepare your submission.
- Upon successful login, an author guide in PDF format will be available to assist you with the submission process.
- Each paper must be submitted as a Word file, accompanied by a PDF version with the same content.
- All submissions must adhere to the Springer paper template (please download and use).
- All submissions must be at least 8 pages in A4 size.
- The page limit includes the title, author(s) name(s) and affiliation(s), abstract, keywords, text body, figures, tables, graphs, and bibliography.
- The organizers are not responsible for and will not copy and edit paper submissions.
- Ensure that all special characters and formatting display correctly.
- All papers must be written in English.
- Submitted papers must meet the minimum scientific standards evaluation.
- All submissions must be original, authored solely by the submitting authors novel, well-described, and relevant to the conference topics, and appropriately referenced.

- Submissions must meet international ethical standards.

Content

Please ensure that your paper contains the following, before submission:

- A title clearly stating the objective of the study
- Full names of all authors, including their ORCID unique identifiers (if available)
- Complete affiliations of all authors
- An abstract (150-250 words) summarizing the key aspects of the paper
- Up to three keywords describing the work of the paper
- The body text organized in sections covering, introduction, materials, methods, results, conclusions, and including figures, tables, and graphs as necessary
- Related bibliography

Formatting

Please follow these guidelines when formatting your paper:

- The paper title is limited to 200 characters, including spaces.
- Capitalize only the first letter of main words in titles, e.g. “Sustainable Practices in Mining”, but do not capitalize all letters!
- Do not use a period in titles and do not place titles in quotes.
- Capitalize initial letters of trade names.
- Do not write given or family names in all caps.
- There is no character limit for author names or affiliations.
- Use standard abbreviations for units of measurement; other abbreviations should be spelled out in full at first mention, followed by the abbreviation in parenthesis [e.g., Resources and Technology (RT)].
- Proofread your work carefully before submission. Ensure both your paper and submission details are correct.
- Fully adhere to the provided Springer paper template. Do not modify fonts, font sizes, spacing, margins, etc.
